Artificial Intelligence (AI) is rapidly transforming the landscape of academic communication. While these technologies present promising opportunities for efficiency, accessibility, and innovation, they also raise critical ethical concerns, including authorship, bias, misinformation, and academic integrity.

This webinar explores the integration of AI into academic communication by focusing on key tools, ethical debates, and emerging opportunities, offering examples from contemporary academia and forecasting potential future trajectories.
